- From 1957 to the mid 1970s the annual Talents Show was a much anticipated and popular event on the Manawatu social calendar.
- Mothers Clubs from Kindergarten Associations in Palmerston North, and Pahiatua, Levin and Marton united to present a joint production of items that ran for two, sometimes, three nights and a matinee at the Opera House, Palmerston North.
- The women wrote the items, made the wardrobes, and assisted kindergarten fathers roped in to build the scenery and backdrops. Whilst an important social get-together for many kindergarten mothers, the show also made a profit that was shared across the kindergartens involved.
- Kindergartens took turns to be the host committee.

'Talents' Rules - who may participate?

Talents Committee Rules stated any married women with children at a kindergarten may take part in the production.

Clarification was sought at a Meeting of Talents Committee on 10th December, 1968. The committee was asked to rule on whether an unmarried mother with a child at kindergarten may participate. The committee asked the Associate Secretary to check on this ruling and advise the committee.

Subsequent minutes are scarce. However an early 1970 memo sent to mothers clubs and social committees continued to assert the original rule.

Change was clarified in the Minutes of Manawatu Kindergarten Talents Committee for May, 1970, Mrs Stevenson reminded delegates that unmarried mothers may participate in 'Talents'. It was suggested that delegates should read the rules to all participants.
